

REPORT OF SEMINARS AND WORKSHOPS

Here is a brief report of seminars and workshops which were organized during the session July 2022 to June 2023 by different departments and societies under the guidance of IQAC.

1. A Workshop organized on Topic: " Emerging Opportunities in Lighting Sector" by NSS Unit of the College on 08.08.2022. Key Note Speaker Mr. I. C. Goyal explained about Lighting Sector. He said that LED technology is rapidly replacing traditional lighting sources such as incandescent bulbs and fluorescent tubes. LED lighting offers several advantages, including energy efficiency, longer lifespan, and lower maintenance costs. As a result, there is a growing demand for LED lighting solutions in residential, commercial, and industrial applications. He also discussed about Smart Lighting i.e, With the advancement of technology, smart lighting systems are becoming increasingly popular. About 104 students and 18 staff members attended this Workshop. The workshop was very interactive.
2. Commerce Society of the College organised Workshop on Topic: " Entrepreneurship: Accounting Aspects" on 10.10.2022. Keynote Speaker Mr. Pradeep Jain, CA explained about Entrepreneurship. He said that Accounting is a crucial aspect of entrepreneurship as it helps entrepreneurs to keep track of their financial transactions, analyze their performance, and take decisions. Here are some important accounting aspects that entrepreneurs need to consider that is Book-keeping. Entrepreneurs should maintain accurate and up-to-date financial records, including recording income, expenses, and assets. Bookkeeping ensures that all financial transactions are properly recorded and can be used to prepare financial statements. In this workshop, around 52 students and 25 staff members participated. The practical aspect of this workshop was very useful for the participants.
3. A Seminar was organised on the Topic: " Research Methodology" by Department of Public Administration on 24.10.2022. Keynote Speaker Dr. Monika Dara explained methods Of Research. She said that Research methodology refers to the systematic approach used by researchers to collect, analyze, and interpret data for a specific research study. It involves outlining the overall research design, selecting appropriate data collection methods, conducting data analysis, test hypothesis and drawing conclusions based on the findings. Around 75 students and 21 staff members attended this seminar.
4. Commerce Society of the College organised a one-day Seminar on the Topic " Intellectual Property (IP) right" on 12.11.2022. Keynote Speaker Sh. B.B Pardhan, explained that Intellectual Property right provides protection for creations of the human mind. These creations include inventions, literary and artistic works, designs, symbols, names, and images used in commerce. The purpose of IP rights is to incentivize innovation and creativity by granting creators and inventors exclusive rights to their creations for a limited period of time. In this seminar, around 120 students and 15 staff members participated. The seminar ended with question-answer session of half an hour.
5. A Workshop was organized on the Topic " Technical Aspects of New Business" by the department of Economics on 06.02.2023. Keynote Speaker Mr. S. D Sharma explained several technical aspects that need to be considered for starting a new business. Setting up a reliable and secure IT infrastructure is essential for any business which includes hardware such as computers, servers, and networking equipment, as well as software such as operating systems, and cybersecurity solutions. Secondly, having a professional and user-friendly website is very important for the success of business. In this Workshop, around 95 students and 12 staff members participated. After the expert talk, a few participants asked many questions and the speaker explained in detail whatever the query was.
